Ani Ma'amin

October 7, 2023 is a day none of us will ever forget. We will never forget the shock and disbelief as the stories about the brutal massacres started materializing. We will never forget the hundreds of inconceivable photos and videos capturing the cruelty and enormity of this tragedy. We will never forget the innocent lives lost and the heroic acts of self-sacrifice, of parents, soldiers and ordinary citizens trying to save their friends, families, and other innocent citizens. The faces of those kidnapped to Gaza, babies, children, elders, and entire families, looking at us from the posters calling for their speedily return, will remain with us for a long time. Words can't truly describe the pain, agony, the shattered worlds of so many people, the broken hearts of every single one of us.

And October 7th broke much more than our hearts...

It tore apart over 1500 families and that number is only climbing. It broke the sacred trust between Israelis and the army that was supposed to protect them. Between them and the government they feel has abandoned them. It broke the concept that Hamas can be a "contained" enemy that can live by our side, a terror organization Israel can reach agreements with and control by giving it incentives to not attack us. It broke the prospect of a potential peace with other Arab countries, without including the Palestinians in such a deal. It fundamentally changed how Israel and the world see Hamas and what Israel is willing to do to defend itself. It might be too early to determine but probably changed the course of history in the Middle East, maybe even beyond the region. It is impossible to know what is next in this war, or how we will move forward.

So many things that we thought we "knew" we need to relearn, rethink, reshape. At a time like this, when are suffering so much loss, a loss of hope, of faith – and we are AT A LOSS, one of the only things we can do – IS ACT.

So, it was not a surprise that almost immediately, I started receiving countless calls asking me – what can I do? I want to help. I want to do my share in supporting Israel and Israelis. After some deliberations – we chose Magen David Adom- Israel's biggest disaster relief as the organization we will support at this time. And I am so proud that our temple members, together with their families and friends, have joined together to help fund emergency ambulances that will save lives in Israel and will carry on then the logo of our Temple, sending a daily message to Israelis that we are standing with them.

At the time of this publication, we have funded four ambulances - \$560,000 !!!!

This tragedy brought us together, this tragedy remined us that our fate and that of Israel are tied together, this tragedy remined us that when one Jew hurts, all Jews hurt – and I hope it has changed us forever, that we will never take our relationship with Israel for granted, that we will always remember the bonds that tie us together as one people, as one family.

I want to thank all of you. You heard the call – and you stood up to the challenge. You gave significantly, and you gave generously, you restored what we all know, but tend to forget, that when we stand together,

when we all do what we know is right, there is nothing that we cannot achieve, there is no challenge too big, no enemy that can break us, no disaster that can stop us.

I pray and hope that never again will we be challenged the way we were on that Saturday morning of October 7th, but if we very are – I know, more than ever before, what I believe in.

Ani Ma'amin,

I believe in the strength of the Jewish people. I believe we need a strong Israel, and we need a strong American Jewish community, and we need them to support each other. I believe that within our community, we can find common goals and ways to support and love each other despite our differences, that we can overcome our differences. I believe that goodness wins, that Israel, Judaism and what we stand for, will win. I believe in our non-Jewish friends and their support, their ability to distinguish between forces of evil and forces of light. I believe in you. I believe in us. I believe in the people of Israel, how strong they are – to protect not what is their land, but what is – our home! I believe that when this is all over, we will be able to rebuild, heal and hold each other's hand, marching forward on this sacred journey to make this world a more just place, a more loving place, a world with no tolerance for hate and the pursuing of peace.







INSCRIBING THEIR FUTURE! One letter at a time...Be a part of our new Sofer Torah!

According to a popular Talmudic tale, a stranger once approached Hillel and Shammai, the great sages of the first century, with a request: "Teach me the Torah while I stand on one foot." First, he brought the request to Shammai. According to the Talmud, Shammai picked up a builder's rule, smacked him alongside his head and dismissed him. So, he came to Hillel. "Teach me the Torah on one foot." Hillel taught him: "That which is hateful to you, do not do to your fellow. That is the whole Torah, all the rest is commentary. *Zil u'gemar*, now, go and learn."

This year we are so excited to welcome over 100 children to our religious school. Each year we select one theme that pervades throughout the year, and along with the Jewish holidays, is taught to all the children – regardless of their age. This year our theme is TORAH.

On Sunday, October 15th and Sunday, October 22nd we kicked off our Torah Project - It is our way to say that we stand with Israel, that we are proud to be Jewish, and that we are committed to our people's future. Together Torah, Nevi'im (Prophets) and Ketuvim (Writings) comprise what is known as the Tanach. This name for the Hebrew Bible is actually made up of the first letter of each of the three sections of the Bible.

T: for Torah N: for Nevi'im Ch: for Ketuvim

The Torah is made up of the first five books of the Hebrew Bible. Sometimes these are referred to as the Five Books of Moses. It may also be called the Chumash, which comes from the word five. The five books are:

Exodus. In Hebrew, Sh'mot. This book details the story of slavery in Egypt, the Exodus, and the Ten Commandments. **November 27**

Leviticus. In Hebrew, Vayikra. The third book of the Torah details the role of the priests and sacrifices in ancient Jewish practice. Leviticus includes many of the ethical and ritual laws that are still practiced today. **December 18**

Numbers. In Hebrew, B'midbar. This book recounts the wandering of the ancient Israelites through the desert and spells out more of God's laws. **January 22**

Deuteronomy. In Hebrew, Devarim. Moses, in his speeches to the Children of Israel offers them an ethical will, beseeching them to follow God's ways as they prepare to enter the Promised Land. **February 12**




